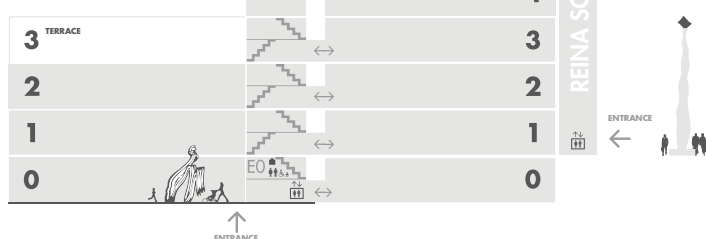

Palacio de Cristal* and Palacio de Velázquez

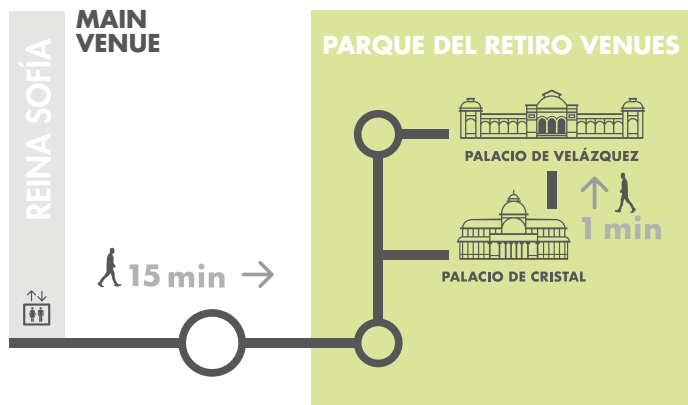
Free admission - Open every day
